Subject: Effective use of 'Aarogyasetu' App for breaking the chain of transmission of COVID-19.

With reference to the subject mentioned above, the following directions may strictly be followed to improve the safety of all Government officials:

- All the officers, staff (including outsourced staff) working in Central (i) Government should download 'Aarogyasetu' App on their mobile phones, immediately.
- (ii) Before starting for office, they must review their status on 'Aarogyasetu' and commute only when the app shows 'safe' or 'low risk' status.
- The officers/staff are advised that in case the App shows a message that he/she (iii) has a 'moderate' or 'high risk' calculated on the basis of Bluetooth proximity ("recent contact with infected person"), he/she should not come to office and self isolate for 14 days or till the status becomes 'safe' or 'low risk'.
- Joint Secretary (Administration) should ensure that above directions are strictly (iv) followed in the respective Ministry/Department.
- (v) Ministries/Departments may issue similar instructions all autonomous/statutory bodies, PSUs etc. attached to them.
